If you plan to apply for consideration, please review the following information.

All candidates must submit:

1. An official copy of your college transcript that notes your GPA
2. Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or pastor/minister (but not more than five)
3. A completed scholarship application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. Submit a thesis statement and 1000-1500 word essay addressing one of the following statement:

History is often written by those in power, leading to the erasure or distortion of marginalized voices. Juneteenth stands as a powerful example of reclaiming history to illuminate the realities of systemic oppression and resistance. How does reclaiming historical narratives shape contemporary movements for justice and equity? Provide examples of historical truths that have been suppressed or rewritten and discuss the impact of restoring these narratives in shaping public consciousness and policy change.

Or

Movements for racial and social justice are often intergenerational, with younger activists building on the foundations laid by those who came before them. What lessons can modern leaders learn from historical figures like Opal Lee, Martin Luther King Jr., or Angela Davis? How can young leaders today apply historical wisdom to contemporary struggles for justice? Reflect on your own role as a bridge between past movements and future progress.
